SUBJECT: Approve City Wide Solar Camera Rental Agreement with Ahern Rental, Inc. in a Total Amount Not to Exceed \$325,900; \$162,000 Annually for a Two-Year Period with No Renewal Option, Plus \$1,900 One-Time Cost for Delivery/Pickup and Transportation Regulatory Fee for Solar Powered Cameras at Various Locations. RECOMMENDATION OR RECOMMEND MOTION: That City Council approve the rental agreement with Ahern Rental Company in a total amount not to exceed \$325,900; \$162,000.00 Annually for the Solar Powered Cameras Plus \$1,900 one- time cost for delivery/pickup and transportation regulatory fee at various locations for a two-year period with no renewal option for solar powered camera rentals citywide.

STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Ahern Rentals Specialty Division is the only rental company that rents the “King Solarman Security Solar Trailers” that come equipped with the two PTZ cameras and two Fixed IPC cameras, along with red and blue strobe lights and a one way PA system. The trailer itself is charge by 4 solar panels and has a battery life that lasts 30 hours without any sunlight.

Public Works has been renting the cameras for various City locations and Parks to monitor the area for vandalism, break-ins and thefts of City vehicles & attachments and high value City owned and rental equipments used at the Flood Channels and other Roadway projects.

Rentals use at the Flood Channels are reimbursable through the Flood Channel maintenance work program from the Clark County Regional Flood Control District.

Public Works is working with IT Department for future monitoring camera systems to limit this rental cost.
