STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

D.R. Horton, Inc. (Developer) has requested that the City of North Las Vegas (City) form a special improvement district within the City pursuant to provisions of Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 271 to levy special assessments, to issue one or more series of bonds to provide for the construction, acquisition, or furnishing of certain public improvements within Special Improvement District No. 66 (Villages at Tule Springs Village 1). This Deposit and Reimbursement Agreement provides for an initial deposit in the amount of \$150,000 for the City to draw against as it incurs the expenses of creating and financing this district. The agreement also provides for the Developer to deposit additional funds as needed and requested by the City. The Memorandum of Understanding details some of the understandings between the City and the Developer relating to the District.
