**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The proposed Citywide School Safety Improvements Project will be a multi-year, multi-phase project to include transportation safety and pedestrian enhancements such as improved visibility, upgraded crosswalks, additional crosswalks, bike paths, safe/walkable routes, landscaping, traffic calming, school flashers, and other items to improve public safety adjacent to local schools. The limits of the project areas are Brian & Teri Cram Middle School, Guy Elementary, and Fitzgerald Elementary.

Two bids were received at the bid opening on December 14, 2021, as detailed on the attached Bid Abstract. CG&B Enterprises Inc. submitted the lowest responsive bid and is properly licensed and qualified to perform the work. The project is required to be completed within 90 calendar days following the issuance of the Notice-to-Proceed.
