STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Clark County Sales and Use Tax Act of 2005 authorized the Board of County Commissioners of Clark County, Nevada to increase the sales and use tax for the purposes of employing and equipping additional police officers for police departments located within Clark County, including the City of North Las Vegas Police Department, and such tax was imposed to be effective on October 1, 2005. On July 20th, 2005 the City of North Las Vegas established a Sales and Use Tax Special Revenue Fund (00288 More Cops Sales Tax Fund) to account for the revenues received that are designated to be used to employ and equip additional police officers for the City which was adopted May 16th 2006, in the FY 2007 Budget. The Act prohibits the use of revenue generated by the tax to replace or supplant existing funding for police departments, and requires the North Las Vegas City Council to make certain determinations and findings consistent with requirements of the Act before it can approve an expenditure of money allocated to the CNLVPD from the proceeds of the tax. The proposed use of money in the FY 2023 budget conforms with all provisions of the Act and does not replace or supplant existing funding for the North Las Vegas Police Department.
