STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Fire Department uses the requested FCC P25 radios as a key communication tool between firefighters and dispatchers during on emergency incidents.

These radios allow the Fire Department to communicate with the Dispatch Center. The current equipment used for this purpose is antiquated and will be disposed of in accordance with City ordinances and State statutes.

The funding source for the radios comes from Fund 268, Tax Override.

The State of Washington entered into a NASPO Lead State Master Agreement with Motorola Solutions, Inc. on January 1, 2022. The State of Nevada entered into a NASPO ValuePoint Participating Addendum number 00318 on February 8, 2022 and authorized all political subdivisions of the state to utilize the terms, conditions, and pricing of the Master Agreement. NRS 332.195 allows the City to enter into a contract with a vendor pursuant to a solicitation by a cooperative purchasing organization.
