**STAFF COMMENTS AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

On May 22, 2019, City Council approved the Purchase Agreement for the purchase of the Clarifloc WE-1154 polymer product used by the Utilities Department at the City’s Water Reclamation Facility (WRF). The City has identified Polydyne as the sole source manufacturer and supplier of Clarifloc WE-1154 for use at the WRF. City Council approved the Purchase Agreement for a one-year term in an annual not to exceed amount of \$700,000.

On August 6, 2020, City Council approved Amendment No. 1 to the Purchase Agreement for four additional years in a not to exceed amount of \$2,800,000 (4 years at not to exceed annual amount of \$700,000).

On September 15, 2021, City Council approved Amendment No. 2 to the Purchase Agreement to increase the not to exceed amount for the three remaining terms of the Agreement from \$700,000 to \$835,000 annually.

Due to an increase in chemical supply prices, staff recommends that the City Council approve Amendment No. 3 to the Clarifloc WE-1154 Purchase Agreement with Polydyne in order to increase the total allocated amount for this Agreement by \$270,400 total (\$135,200 annually for two years) for the remaining term of the Agreement, funded by the Utilities Enterprise Fund, for Clarifloc WE-1154 for the WRF.
