4. <u>Discuss the Completion of the FY2018-2019 Grant Cycle and Progress of the FY2019-2020 Grant Cycle. (Non-Action Item)</u>

Neighborhood Services Coordinator Christison provided members with information that reflected the 2020 grant cycle and how much was awarded. Lutheran Social Services lost several staff members during COVID and were unable to provide the same amount of senior meal deliveries as before. However, they continued to provide the services but did not have enough staff to assist with the required paperwork. Lutheran Social Services returned some of the money from the grant to the City. In addition, there was an issue with the YMCA not being able to sign up kids during COVID. Therefore, giving them a late start and it resulted in the City taking back some of the funding. The money received from both agencies were allocated to Three Square. Neighborhood Services Coordinator Christison provided additional information regarding the other grants that were awarded.

5. <u>Update of Current Grant Activities for Housing and Neighborhood Services.</u> (Non-Action Item)

Neighborhood Services Coordinator Christison stated that North Las Vegas is teaming up with Clark County, City of Henderson and City of Las Vegas to help end homelessness with a program called Operation HOME. Funding for this program comes from leftover money from the COVID fund. The current goal is to house 2,022 people by December 2022. There are currently 13 non-profits that are involved and helping to get the program established.

Committee members and staff held a discussion regarding different non-profit agencies that can help and what can be offered, such as furniture, clothing, etc.

Neighborhood Services Coordinator Christison also mentioned that the department has used some of their COVID funds to create their own street outreach team and this came from the City Manager's office. This will help bring homeless people to shelters, provide shower and laundry services.
